



“WHEN DREAMS COME TRUE”

PROPOSAL FOR NON-PROFIT STATUS



Statement of Purpose:

To provide a dream to a resident who has a terminal diagnosis or for a resident who has always had a dream, but never had the opportunity to achieve his/her dream.

Dreams will be drawn on a monthly basis. If someone has a terminal illness, that dream will be acted upon before any others to insure the reality of this dream for the Scottsdale Village Square Resident before they expire, otherwise it will be a random drawing, showing no favoritism at any time.

EXAMPLES:

Dreams that may be fulfilled can come from many sources. For instance: a ride in a corvette convertible followed by a candlelight dinner with the husband and wife (catered in); a trip to a Casino with \$50.00 in cash to spend any way the resident wants; attendance at the performance of “Phantom of the Opera”; a visit to a dude ranch.

HOW DREAMS ARE SUBMITTED:

Dreams can be submitted at any time in writing or voiced to a staff person who then passes it on to the proper people in charge of the program, that being The Activity Director. Forms are available in the Activity Office at any time and are published in each facility newsletter so that families are also aware of the “Dreams” program. Dreams will then be looked at carefully to determine feasibility of fulfilling, i.e., safety of resident, costs of dream, etc. If there are no drawbacks, then the dream date is set and the staff person assigned to help make the dream come true. Families are contacted letting them know that they too can participate in the dream if they so desire or if the resident has requested their presence.

DONATIONS:

Donations can come from many resources - family donations, resident donations, staff donations, community donations or gifts, and fundraising. Monies donated are then placed in the account and when monies are needed, a purchase order is done to request use of the monies and all receipts then are submitted upon completion of the dream.
